Carillon Bantam Options Community Level

Cost- Set by community club

Skill Level- All skills levels are eligible.

Schedule- 1-2 games per week from the first week of May until end of June. Games are scheduled during the week (usually tues./thurs). Teams are seeded as per competition level for league playoffs. Season is complete after league playoffs.

Make up of Team- Ideally each community will have their own team, if not the league will put communities together to make a team.

Dedication level- Depends on the expectations of the coach of the team/community club.

Goal- To give players, who are not able to commit to an intensive schedule, the opportunity to participate in and develop baseball skills. To allow more opportunities for the players, who will participate in the provincial league and AAA program. To allow small communities to be able to offer a team. This is beneficial to community building and increases the amount of kids playing baseball in the Carillon region.

Provincial Level

*All players interested in this level must also participate at the Community level.

Cost- \$35 (this is in addition to previously paid community level fee)

Skill- All skill levels are eligible.

Schedule- 2-3 dates with games will be scheduled during May and June as well as playoffs in June.

Make up of team- Depending on interest level a community may have their own team or the league will create centers to make team. Registration will take place in May.

Dedication level- This level asks for a higher level of dedication. It is expected that they are able to participate in all or the majority of the games scheduled above. If not and the player is interested, communication needs to be made with the coach/town rep. as that is necessary info for the make-up of the teams. The league champions (1st) will represent Carillon at the baseball Manitoba AA provincials on July 18th-20th 2nd place will represent Carillon at the "A" provincials on July 11th-13th.

Goal- To give interested players the opportunity to further develop their baseball skills and play more baseball. To allow communities to come together to create a team which will lead to productive relationships for the players/communities as they continue in sport.

*There has been the idea that this level is for elite baseball players only. That is incorrect, if a player is willing to dedicate themselves they can participate at this level regardless of skill level.

AAA Level

Cost-Will be decided at a later date.

Skill- Elite players

Schedule- Team participates in a tournament in June and provincials in July. Practices and exhibition games are held from March- July, but do not conflict with provincial and community league games

Make up of team- The team consists of 12 players chosen amongst all players in the Carillon League. Coaches choose players based on tryouts and observation of Community and Provincial level games.

Dedication Level- Only players that can dedicate themselves to the level the coach wants will be chosen for the team.

Goal-To provide an environment for the elite players of the region to participate against the best from the Province and Country. It also provides a stage for our local players to be considered for Manitoba Provincial Teams.
